- The proposed restoration works and costs
 - An Organ Advisor's or Organ Consultant's report
 - The organisation's accounts, with evidence of funds available to complete the proposed works
 - Details of the faculty application or any necessary permissions for the proposed works.
- 5 Please provide evidence of the viability of the establishment. This should be a written statement of no more than 200 words indicating numbers using the building, the frequency with which the organ is used and any other information that the applicant feels is relevant.
